

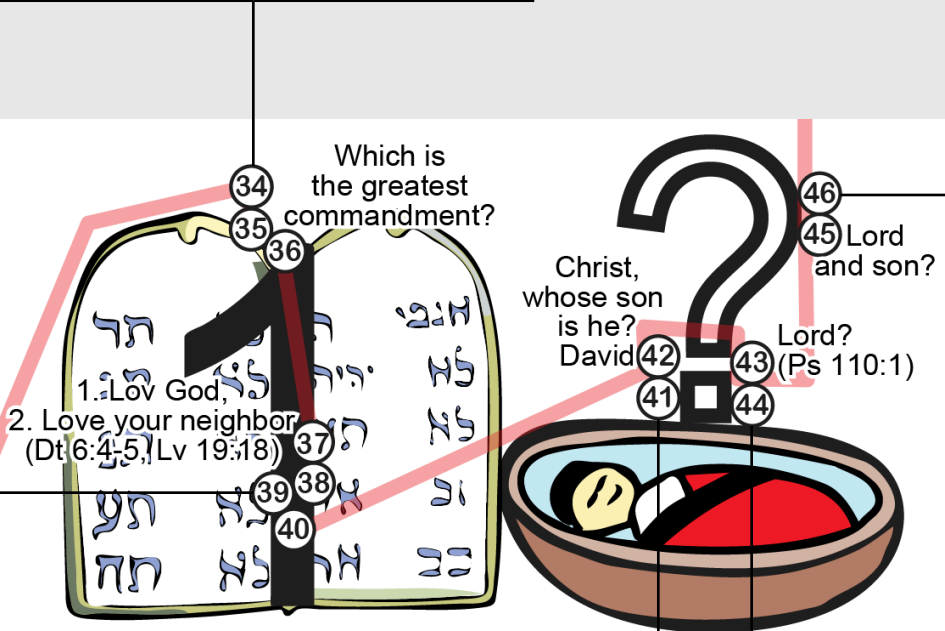

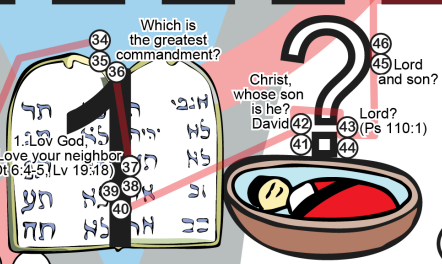
37 Jesus said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind."

 46 No one was able to answer him a word, neither dared any man from that day forth ask him any more questions.

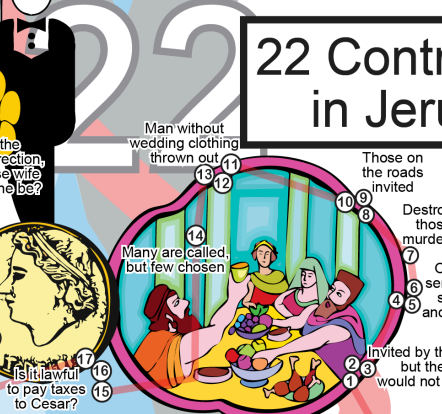
