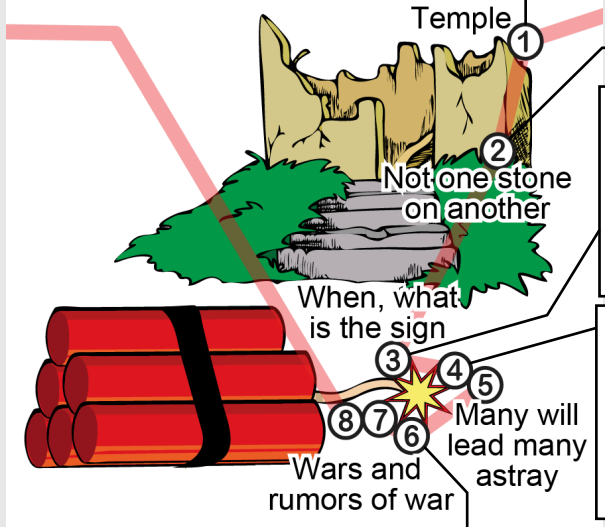


March 27 - **Matthew 24:1-8**
Destruction of the Temple
The Beginning of Pains

1 Καὶ ἐξελθὼν ὁ Ἰησοῦς ἀπὸ τοῦ ἱεροῦ ἐπορεύετο, καὶ προσήλθον οἱ μαθηταὶ αὐτοῦ ἐπιδειξάσαι αὐτῷ τὰς οἰκοδομὰς τοῦ ἱεροῦ.
 1 Jesus went out from the temple, and was going on his way. His disciples came to him to show him the buildings of the temple.

2 But he answered them, **“Don’t you see all of these things? Most assuredly I tell you, there will not be left here one stone on another, that will not be thrown down.”**

2 ὁ δὲ ἀποκριθεὶς εἶπεν αὐτοῖς· οὐ βλέπετε ταῦτα πάντα; ἀμὴν λέγω ὑμῖν, οὐ μὴ ἀφεθῆ ὧδε λίθος ἐπὶ λίθον ὃς οὐ καταλυθήσεται.



3 As he sat on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to him privately, saying, **“Tell us, when will these things be? What is the sign of your coming, and of the end of the age?”**

3 Καθημένου δὲ αὐτοῦ ἐπὶ τοῦ ὄρους τῶν Ἐλαιῶν προσήλθον αὐτῷ οἱ μαθηταὶ κατ’ ἰδίαν λέγοντες **Εἶπόν ἡμῖν, πότε ταῦτα ἔσται, καὶ τί τὸ σημεῖον τῆς σῆς παρουσίας καὶ συντελείας τοῦ αἰῶνος;**

4 Jesus answered them, **“Be careful that no one leads you astray. 5 For many will come in my name, saying, ‘I am the Christ,’ and will lead many astray.**

4 καὶ ἀποκριθεὶς ὁ Ἰησοῦς εἶπεν αὐτοῖς **Βλέπετε μὴ τις ὑμᾶς πλανήσῃ· 5 πολλοὶ γὰρ ἐλεύσονται ἐπὶ τῷ ὀνόματί μου λέγοντες Ἐγὼ εἰμι ὁ χριστός, καὶ πολλοὺς πλανήσουσιν.**

6 You will hear of wars and rumors of wars. See that you aren’t troubled, for all this must happen, but the end is not yet.
 7 For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom; and there will be famines, plagues, and earthquakes in various places.
 8 But all these things are the beginning of birth pains.

6 μελλήσετε δὲ ἀκούειν πολέμους καὶ ἀκοὰς πολέμων· ὁράτε, μὴ θροεῖσθε· δεῖ γὰρ γενέσθαι, ἀλλ’ οὐπω ἐστὶν τὸ τέλος.
 7 ἐγερθήσεται γὰρ ἔθνος ἐπὶ ἔθνος καὶ βασιλεία ἐπὶ βασιλείαν, καὶ ἔσονται λιμοὶ καὶ σεισμοὶ κατὰ τόπους·
 8 πάντα δὲ ταῦτα ἀρχὴ ὠδίνων.
