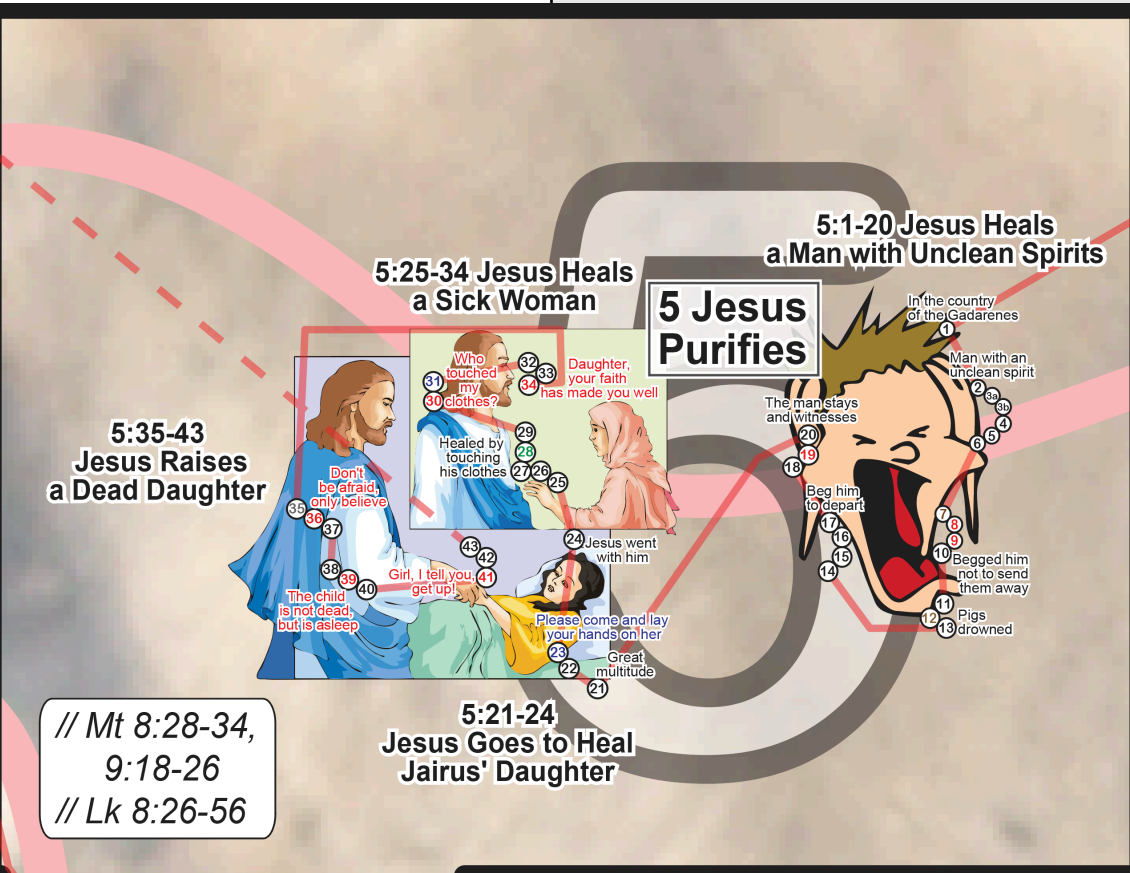
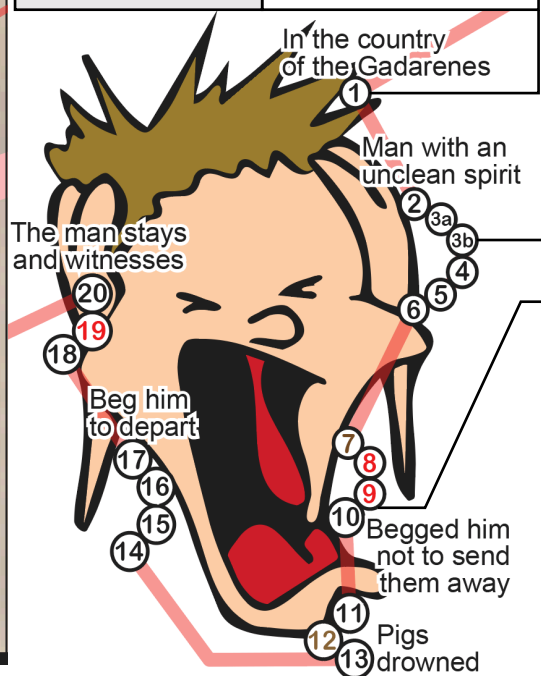
2 When he had come out of the boat, immediately there met him out of the tombs a man with an unclean spirit,

 10 He begged him much that he would not send them away out of the country.
