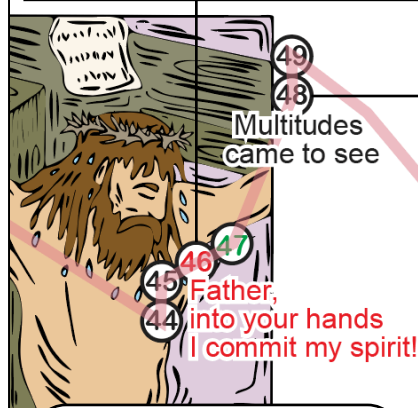


44 It was now about the sixth hour, and darkness came over the whole land until the ninth hour.
