

April 9 - Matthew 27:1-10  
Judas' Death

1 Πρωίας δὲ γενομένης συνβούλιον ἔλαβον πάντες οἱ ἀρχιερεῖς καὶ οἱ πρεσβύτεροι τοῦ λαοῦ κατὰ τοῦ Ἰησοῦ ὥστε θανατώσαι αὐτόν·  
2 καὶ δήσαντες αὐτόν ἀπήγαγον καὶ παρέδωκαν Πειλάτῳ τῷ ἡγεμόνι.


1 Now when morning had come, all the chief priests and the elders of the people took counsel against Jesus to put him to death:  
2 and they bound him, and led him away, and delivered him up to Pontius Pilate, the governor.

3 Τότε ἰδὼν Ἰούδας ὁ παραδοὺς αὐτόν ὅτι κατεκρίθη, μεταμεληθεὶς ἔστρεψεν τὰ τριάκοντα ἀργύρια τοῖς ἀρχιερεῦσιν καὶ πρεσβυτέροις  
4 λέγων Ἡ μάρτον παραδοὺς αἷμα δίκαιον. οἱ δὲ εἶπαν Τί πρὸς ἡμᾶς; σὺ ὄψη.  
5 καὶ ρίψας τὰ ἀργύρια εἰς τὸν ναὸν ἀνεχώρησεν, καὶ ἀπελθὼν ἀπήγγαστο.

3 Then Judas, who betrayed him, when he saw that Jesus was condemned, felt remorse, and brought back the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders,  
4 saying, "I have sinned in that I betrayed innocent blood." But they said, "What is that to us? You see to it."  
5 He threw down the pieces of silver in the sanctuary, and departed. He went away and hanged himself.

9 Τότε ἐπληρώθη τὸ ῥηθὲν διὰ Ἰερεμίου τοῦ προφήτου λέγοντος  
Καὶ ἔλαβον τὰ τριάκοντα ἀργύρια, τὴν τιμὴν τοῦ τετιμημένου ὃν ἐτιμήσαντο ἀπὸ υἱῶν Ἰσραὴλ,  
10 καὶ ἔδωκαν αὐτὰ εἰς τὸν ἀγρὸν τοῦ κεραμέως, καθὰ συνέταξέν μοι Κύριος.

9 Then that which was spoken through Jeremiah the prophet was fulfilled, saying,  
"They took the thirty pieces of silver, The price of him upon whom a price had been set, Whom some of the children of Israel priced,  
10 And they gave them for the potter's field, As the Lord commanded me."

Labels in the graphic include: King of the Jews crucified, Mocked, Two robbers, My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?, He is calling Elijah, Death, veil torn, tombs open, centurion's witness, Body in a tomb, Two Marys at the Tomb, Joseph of Arimathea asks for Jesus' body, Made the tomb secure, Command to secure the tomb, Led to crucifixion, Struck on the head, Scarlet robe and crown of thorns, Jesus to be Crucified, Release Barrabas, Whom do you want me to release?, Wife's dream, Are you the king of the Jews?, Jesus delivered up to Pilate, Judas hanged himself, Chief priests bought the potter's field, Zach 11:13.

6 The chief priests took the pieces of silver, and said, "It's not lawful to put them into the treasury, since it is the price of blood."  
7 They took counsel, and bought the potter's field with them, to bury strangers in.  
8 Therefore that field was called "The Field of Blood" to this day.

7 συνβούλιον δὲ λαβόντες ἡγόρασαν ἐξ αὐτῶν τὸν Ἄγρον τοῦ Κεραμέως εἰς ταφὴν τοῖς ξένοις.  
8 διὸ ἐκλήθη ὁ ἀγρὸς ἐκεῖνος Ἄγρος Αἱματος ἕως τῆς σήμερον.
