


Beginning of the Disciples' Ministry



13 Οὐαί σοι, Χοραζεῖν· οὐαί σοι, Βηθσαΐδᾳ· ὅτι εἰ ἐν Τύρῳ καὶ Σιδῶν ἐγένηθησαν αἱ δυνάμεις αἱ γενόμεναι ἐν ὑμῖν, πάλαι ἀν ἐν σάκκῳ καὶ σποδῷ καθήμενοι μετενόησαν.
14 πλὴν Τύρῳ καὶ Σιδῶνι ἀνεκτότερον ἔσται ἐν τῇ κρίσει ἡ ὑμῖν.

Woe to Unrepentant Cities
Return of the 72

17 Ὑπέστρεψαν δὲ οἱ ἐβδομήκοντα [δύο] μετὰ χαρᾶς λέγοντες Κύριε, καὶ τὰ δαιμόνια ὑποτάσσεται ἡμῖν ἐν τῷ ὄνόματί σου.

17 The seventy returned with joy, saying, "Lord, even the demons are subject to us in your name!"

13 "Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! For if the mighty works had been done in Tyre and Sidon which were done in you, they would have repented long ago, sitting in sackcloth and ashes.
14 But it will be more tolerable for Tyre and Sidon in the judgment than for you.

15 You, Capernaum, who are exalted to heaven, will be brought down to Hades.

15 Καὶ σύ, Καφαρναούμ, μὴ ἔως οὐρανοῦ ὑψωθήσῃ; ἔως τοῦ ἥδου καταβήσῃ.

16 Whoever listens to you listens to me, and whoever rejects you rejects me. Whoever rejects me rejects him who sent me."

16 Οἱ ἀκούων ὑμῶν ἔμοι ἀκούει, καὶ ὁ ἀθετῶν ὑμᾶς ἔμε ἀθετεῖ· ὁ δὲ ἔμε ἀθετῶν ἀθετεῖ τὸν ἀποστείλαντά με.



18 He said to them, "I saw Satan having fallen like lightning from heaven.
19 Behold, I give you authority to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy. Nothing will in any way hurt you.

18 εἶπεν δὲ αὐτοῖς Ἐθεώρουν τὸν Σατανᾶν ὡς ἀστραπὴν ἐκ τοῦ οὐρανοῦ πεσόντα.
19 ιδοὺ δέδωκα ὑμῖν τὴν ἔξουσίαν τοῦ πατεῖν ἐπάνω ὄφεων καὶ σκορπίων, καὶ ἐπὶ πᾶσαν τὴν δύναμιν τοῦ ἔχθροῦ, καὶ οὐδὲν ὑμᾶς οὐ μὴ ἀδικήσει.
