

February 10 - **Matthew 12:16-21**
God's Chosen Servant

15 Ὁ δὲ Ἰησοῦς γνοὺς ἀνεχώρησεν ἐκεῖθεν. Καὶ ἠκολούθησαν αὐτῷ πολλοί, καὶ ἐθεράπευσεν αὐτοὺς πάντας, 16 καὶ ἐπέτιμήσεν αὐτοῖς ἵνα μὴ φανερὸν αὐτὸν ποιήσωσιν·

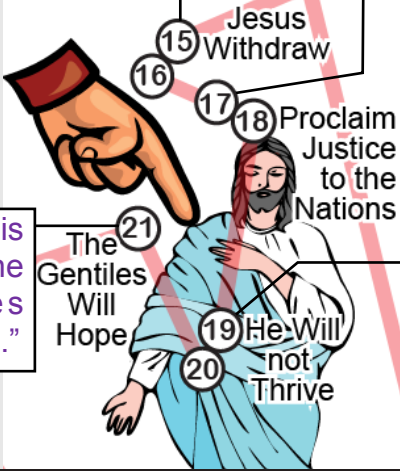
15 Jesus, perceiving that, withdrew from there. Great multitudes followed him; and he healed them all, 16 and charged them that they should not make him known:

17 that it might be fulfilled which was spoken through Isaiah the prophet, saying, 18 “Behold, my servant whom I have chosen; My beloved in whom my soul is well pleased: I will put my Spirit on him. He will proclaim justice to the Gentiles.

21 καὶ τῷ ὀνόματι αὐτοῦ ἔθνη ἐλπιούσιν.

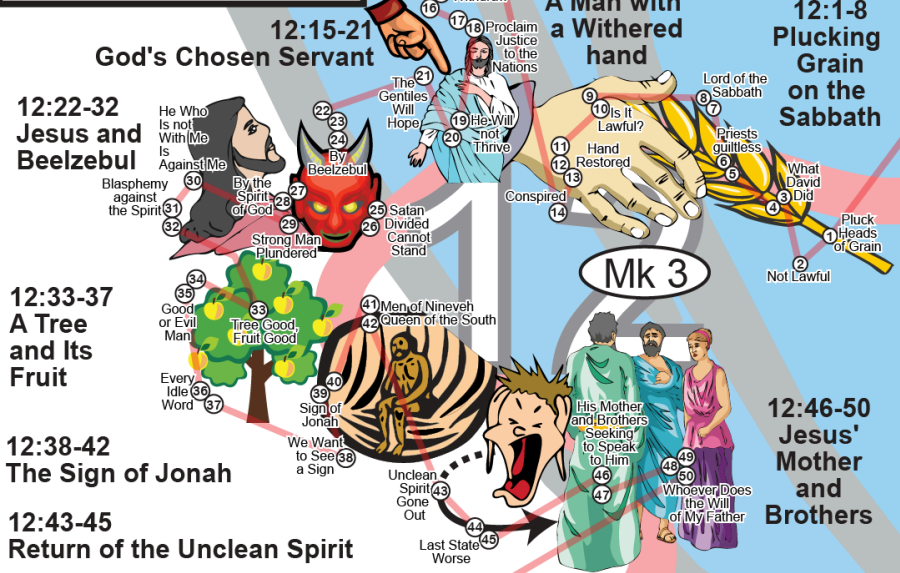
21 In his name, the Gentiles will hope.”
